

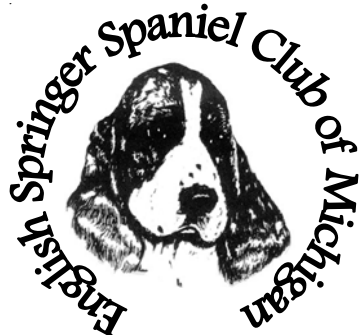

In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8 - Veteran Dogs & Bitches may be spayed or neutered at Specialty Shows. Winners of the above classes may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated the day of the show.

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**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Award will be based on the merits of two of the Get. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible. **Entry fee for this class is \$20.00 for the unit or \$16.00 if Stud Dog is entered in a Regular Class.**

**Brood Bitch Class.** Same as Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

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As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

**Brace Class.** Each Brace shall be composed of two English Springer Spaniels owned by identical owner. All braces must be entered in the Brace Class and shown in the ring at the same time. Show Class as "Conf. Brace" on entry form. Registered name of the other half of the brace must be indicated on the entry form. Each dog must be individually entered in one of the Breed Classes for which an entry fee is required. **Entry fee is \$20.00 for the unit.**

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
